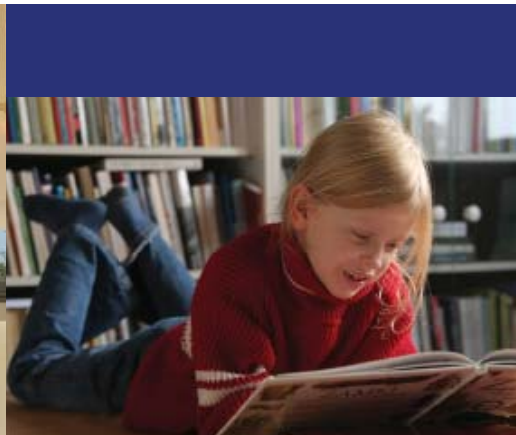

WEMTA PET Scholarships:

The Permanent Endowment Trust makes it possible for WEMTA to offer the following scholarships:

- **The Doctoral Studies Scholarship** provides funding for a doctoral student enrolled in a university program that prepares educators of future school library media and instructional technology specialists.
- **The Lowell Wilson Scholarship** encourages strong leaders to gain the certification required for serving as Library Media and Instructional Technology Specialists in our schools. This scholarship provides funding to cover tuition costs for graduate level coursework leading to licensure.

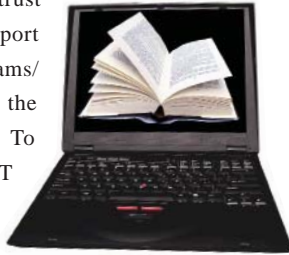

## WHAT IS PET?

The WEMTA Permanent Endowment Trust (PET) was established in 1992 with the understanding that additional contributions would increase the endowment fund, but that the interest earned by the trust would be used to support special or unique programs/projects of benefit to the WEMTA membership. To date, the WEMTA PET has provided over \$40,000 in scholarships and project



grants to Wisconsin recipients. Donations to PET are tax deductible.

The Permanent Endowment Trust also makes it possible for WEMTA to fund innovative projects on an annual basis. Outreach proposals should address one of three areas:

- Programs and projects that provide a direct and recognizable benefit to the members of WEMTA.



- Programs and projects which support innovation in school library media or instructional technology programs.
- Community programs that promote partnerships within the profession.
